

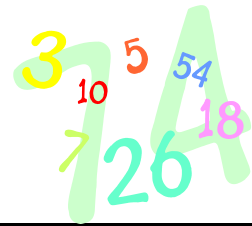

## Top tips for talking

### **How you can help.....**

Take part in activities together to encourage talking e.g. craft, cooking, rhyme time, stay and play.

**Why?...**because language needs to be practiced every day for these skills to develop,

### **So try to...**

\*Do different things with your child to help them develop lots of new words.

\*Singing songs and rhymes is a great way to develop your child's language-the brain loves music and rhyme.

\*Leave words out of their favourite song or rhyme. I'll huff and I'll puff and I'll ---- your house down.

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
